Where Did God Come From?

How would you answer the question, "Where did God come from"?

This question has been asked by sincere, well-meaning people. On occasion, the Ω is asked in Creation v. Evolution Debates by those who would deny God's existence. When pressed to explain where matter and energy in the universe originated, the atheist often responds, "You tell me where God came from and I'll tell you where matter and energy came from." The intent is to create a stalemate that prevents him from having to answer the question on the origins of matter and energy, His rationale: "Christians can't answer the question of the origin of God, and so I will not answer the question of the origin of matter and energy,

This attempt at subterfuge doesn't work for these reasons:

- 1. The atheist is comparing apples and oranges
 - He's equating matter and energy both of which have been proven scientifically to require an origin in time and space – with God, Who has no origin
 - The atheist is trying to equate the non-eternal and temporal (matter and energy) with the eternal (God)
 - This comparison has no validity because it is illogical and impossible to compare non-eternal with the eternal
- As a result of his mistake, the atheist has posed what is termed in philosophy a "nonsensical" question, that is he has asked a question that makes no sense
 - Nonsensical questions cannot be answered <u>because</u> of the very fact that they make no sense
 - The atheist asked, "Where did God come from?", which implies that God came from somewhere – that is He had an origin
 - But by definition, God is Eternal He has no origin because eternal entitles do not have origins – they are eternal
 - So the atheist has erred in ascribing some kind of origin to an eternal entity (God), however
 - God did not "come from" anywhere, for is He "going anywhere" –
 That would require an origin and an end or destination when in fact,
 God has neither.
- 3. The scriptures speak clearly of God's eternal nature. Let's look briefly at five (5) scriptures:
 - Deut. 33.27 Speaks of "the eternal God"
 - Psa. 90: 2 The Psalmist referred to God as "He who is from everlasting to everlasting"
 - o Isa. 57:15 Isaiah observed that it is God who inhabits eternity
 - Psa. 102:24 The writer spoke of the Earth and the heavens, and noted that "they shall perish, but thou (God) shalt endure...Thy years have no end"
 - Exo. 3:14 God Himself told Moses, "I AM THAT I AM", which is the formula for self-existence

God is the Eternal One Who has always existed, and Who always will exist He lives in the ever-present. So, a person may not legitimately describe God as a being who "has been" or "will be"; rather, God is described as without beginning or end — thereby precluding any "origin". Likewise, He has no destiny.

So then, can a person logically ask the question, "Where did God come from?" It is in the truest sense of the word a "nonsensical question".
